Who's the most popular *cartoon character* (卡通角色) in China now? It might be Peppa. This little girl pig is the main character on the British TV show Peppa Pig.

The show has been on TV in 40 languages in more than 180 countries and *regions* (地区). It's about the everyday lives of the Peppa Pig family members. The show is mainly for *preschoolers* (学前儿童). But many older kids and even *adults* (成年人) have become fans of the show as well.

"I think its popularity is partly because of being ageless." A voice actor said.

The show's stories are simple, but not too **childish**. Peppa makes both kids and adults laugh.

For example, in one *episode* (集), Peppa is unhappy because she doesn't know how to *whistle* (吹口哨). She phones her friend, Susie Sheep, to ask her if she can whistle. Susie says she can try to do it. She succeeds on her first try! Peppa feels even worse! She *hangs up* (挂电话) angrily.

Peppa isn't perfect. But she is very real, and so are the other characters on the show. And that makes the show quite special.

What will you do during a vacation? Visit famous places, shop or take photos? There is one thing you should never forget to do – send a postcard.

Postcards first *appeared* (出现) in October 1865 in the UK. By the 20th century(世纪), trains became a cheap and easy way to travel. More people went on holiday to the seaside. There were no cellphones, so they sent postcards to let others know they arrived safely. Those postcards usually showed seaside pictures, such as beaches or some seafood.

Today, most postcards are local *scenery* (风景) photos or drawings. Others may be funny, with jokes on the front.

People usually write words to express that they miss someone on their postcards. It's *common* (普遍的) to end with "thinking of you." The most common postcard words are "wish you were here."

Modern postcards also show British *humor* (幽默). They often make fun of British weather. For example, some postcards show heavy rain on an empty beach. This humor keeps postcards popular in Britain.
